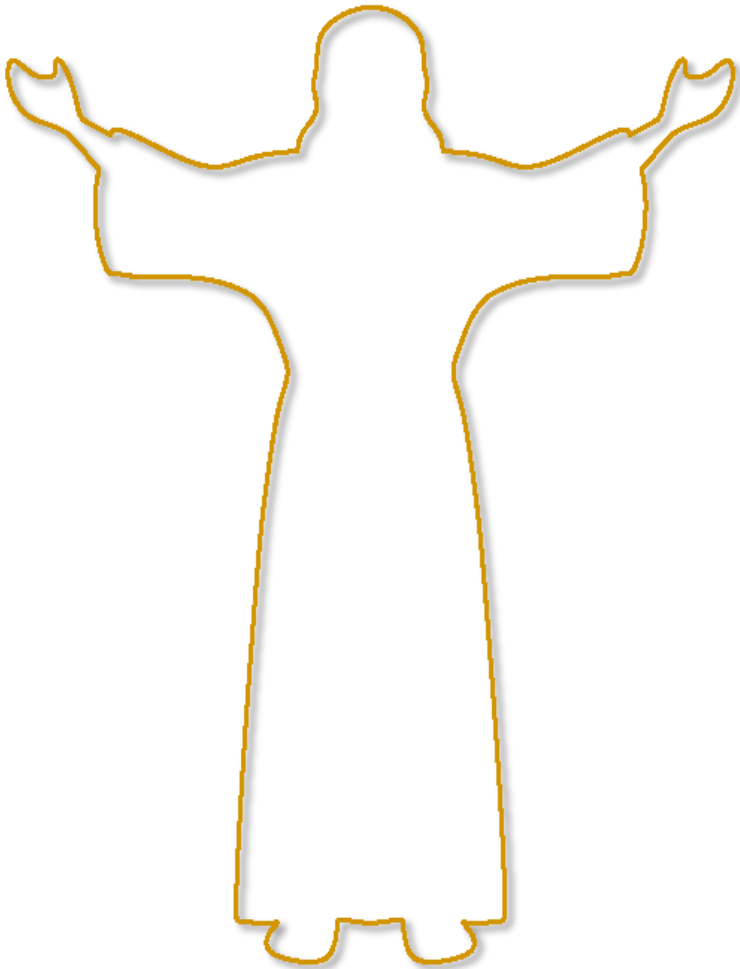

2nd Sunday of Lent

The Transfiguration of Jesus

“This is my Son, whom I have chosen.
Listen to him.”

GATHER

Make the sign of the cross as you say the Glory Be prayer

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen

WORD - LISTEN

Read or listen to the reading from the Gospel of Saint Luke (9:28-36)

Jesus takes three disciples, Peter, John and James, up a hill to pray. Whilst they are there, Jesus's appearance changes and the disciples wake up to see Jesus in his glory.

RESPOND

Create the background on the front cover of Jesus in his glory. Use colouring pencils, wax crayons, paints, collage or other art materials.

Extra

Listen to and watch “The Transfiguration” from Mark’s Gospel (Streetlights Bible) or read the account from Luke’s Gospel again.

Imagine you are with Peter, James and John.

How do you feel when ...?

You are walking up the hill with Jesus

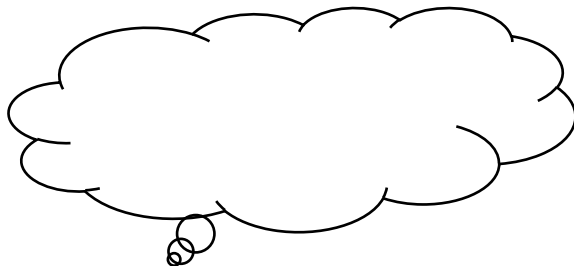
You wake up and see that Jesus’s appearance has changed.
