

Social media problems......

We are continuing our online safety and online behaviour work with the children. We are using different programmes in school to explain how to keep safe online. These programmes have been developed with CEOP. This is their web address: https://ceop.police.uk/safety-centre

Please do have a look at this at home with your children. Year 6 are also doing some special online safety work with Mrs Humphries as they learn how to BLOG safely online.

Mr de Koning conducted an in-school survey, and found that, at the moment, our children mainly use the following social media apps at home to keep in contact with each other: Instagram, Snapchat and Roblox.

Young people are supposed to be 13 before they are allowed on Instagram and Snapchat. Some of our years 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 children regularly use these programmes.

Roblox has been widely criticised for having no filtering on it ~ this means your child can talk to people they DO NOT KNOW. It is very difficult to convince children that as adults we DO know what we are talking about. However, it is really important that we all continue to have open discussions with the children to warn them of the online dangers of talking to people that they would not talk to in the 'real world'.

We are also having some issues with children believing that TYPING mean and disrespectful things online is not the same as SAYING them to someone face to face. The children do not seem to realise that once something is online it is not only available for ANYONE to read, it becomes the property of the social app and it is there FOREVER. Photos and words cannot be deleted. They can be deleted from your own devices but they remain in the i cloud FOREVER.
