

Environmental News

The banning of single use plastics is going very well. There is now a huge reduction in the number of children bringing in single use plastic bottles ~ the great majority of children are arriving at school with their own cups which they can freely use throughout the day. We have a brilliant water fountain in school and the children say that the water tastes "lovely and fresh!" Children who stay for packed lunch should pack a cup as water is available freely at lunchtimes for ALL of the children.

Please remember that children are NOT allowed to bring any kind of juice or fizzy drinks to school! We actively encourage the children at St George's to drink only water or milk.

Fresh fruit is available at break times for children or children can bring in their own healthy snack. Please remember that sweets and crisps are not allowed at breaktimes. Please do not send these in. Thank you.



TIMES TABLES ROCKSTARS

Every child in school now has a log in for Times Tables Rockstars. Your child knows how to use this programme and we would love them to use this new programme as much as possible AT HOME. It is vitally important that your child knows ALL of their times tables by the middle of Year 4.

The children who know all of their tables off by heart make excellent progress in maths. Times tables are needed for multiplication, division and fractions. Your child needs to learn the inverse too:

For example:

 $8 \times 9 = 72$ and $72 \div 9 = 8$ and $72 \div 8 = 9$ $7 \times 8 = 56$ and $56 \div 8 = 7$ and $72 \div 7 = 8$

We will be running more maths workshops for parents in the Autumn term to show you how we teach division, multiplication, addition and subtraction and we will show you lots of ways to help your children at home!
