## Are you be interested in becoming a school crossing patrol officer?

# You could apply for this very important role if you're:

- looking for part time paid work
- can spare up to 10 hours per week during school term-time
- enjoy being outside in all weathers
- want to help your local community

#### Applicants must:

- be in good health
- be able to work in all weather conditions
- be able to communicate well
- have a general knowledge of The Highway Code
- undergo an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service DBS check

### School crossing patrols work:

- between 8 and 10 hours a week
- between 45 and 60 minutes each day
- term time only
- Alternatively, you can apply to assist with school crossing relief to cover the duties of an existing school crossing patrol attendant if they're not able to work for any reason

Full uniform and training is provided!



## Parent and carer responsibility ~

Even where a school crossing exists, parents and carers are responsible for:

- ensuring their children's safety on the journey to and from school
- collecting children at the end of the school day

## Advice for drivers at school crossings

When you're driving near a school crossing:

- be courteous and patient
- slow down if you see flashing warning lights near a school
- be aware of your responsibilities as a driver
