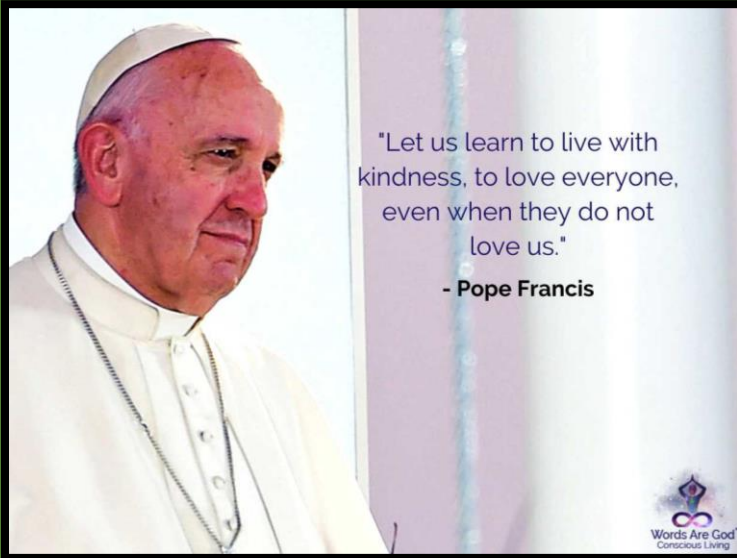


Latest School News From Mrs Statham

Are you be interested in becoming our school crossing patrol officer?

You could apply for this very important role if you're:

- looking for part time paid work
- can spare up to 10 hours per week during school term-time
- enjoy being outside in all weathers
- want to help your local community

Applicants must:

- be in good health
- be able to work in all weather conditions
- be able to communicate well
- have a general knowledge of The Highway Code
- undergo an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service DBS check

School crossing patrols work:

- between 8 and 10 hours a week
- between 45 and 60 minutes each day
- term time only
- Alternatively, you can apply to assist with school crossing relief to cover the duties of an existing school crossing patrol attendant if they're not able to work for any reason
