
Latest School News From Mrs Statham

It is important for us all to remember how much school has been interrupted for the children since March 2020.


We know that the best way for children to 'catch up' is by offering outstanding quality teaching.

The hours of work are from 12 noon until 13:15 assisting with school lunches, helping children and supervising after lunch playtime.



You could apply for this very important role if you're:

- looking for part time paid work
- can spare up to 10 hours per week during school termtime
- eniov being outside in all weathers
- want to help your local community

Applicants must:

- be in good health
- be able to work in all weather conditions
- be able to communicate well
- have a general knowledge of The Highway Code
- undergo an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service DBS check

School crossing patrols work:

- between 8 and 10 hours a week
- between 45 and 60 minutes each day
- term time only
- Alternatively, you can apply to assist with school crossing relief to cover the duties of an existing school crossing patrol attendant if they're not able to work for any reason
