Safeguarding Governor survey of Pupils' Views - June 2022

Groups of children from Y1/2, Y3/4 and Y5/6 were came to meet AM and LB to answer our Pupil Voice questions.

Questions were asked relating to safety both in school and online. St George's has always been very active in educating the children about safety of all types from anti-bullying to online safety and personal safety.

It was clear that the children were enjoying being back at school and having their friends around them, but also having the opportunity to learn new things.

At all ages the children were very aware of what did and didn't make them feel safe both in school and out of school. They knew who they could go to if they didn't feel safe, either their parents, teachers or an adult at school, their friends or Flutterby Friends. All children knew how to identify Flutterby Friends if they needed help.

The main way children felt safe at school is having people they could trust. Both adults and older children.

The areas children felt least safe were outside and for the older children on their way home – feeling uneasy sometimes if strange people were walking in their direction.

All ages were also aware of online bullying, but they knew how they could prevent it, by switching off games, not accepting strangers as friends etc or simply not playing the game.

When it comes to the schools' approach to bullying the children did say that school does get people to stop doing it. They watch everyone in the playground and everyone to listens to the teachers. School also has rules in place eg use kind hands and feet which tell you what you should be doing. One child feels the school is actually bulletproof when it comes to bullying.

Overall, the children feel safe, secure, and listened to at school. They know who to go to if they need to. They know how to protect themselves online and outside of school also and most of all love being at St George's.

How has the year at St George's been for you so far?
