Here are the results of the recent Parents' Questionnaire!
We had 162 responses.

The following were highlighted as strengths from the survey and from additional parent comments:

- 161/162 parents said they would recommend St George's to another parent
- Many of you highlighted that you had already recommended us to other parents
- 100% of you said that your child feels safe at school
- Many of our parents who have transferred from other schools, highlighted the fact that important dates are given a year in advance and felt that communication with parents was outstanding
- Several parents commented on the 'happy family' atmosphere at school which they said was very important for their child

Things that school can do better:

- Some parents highlighted that they don't know about the range of subjects we teach
- Some parents said they didn't think there was a good range of clubs etc.
- Some parents felt that communication could be better

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Bullying concerns:

- 2% of parents said that their child had experienced bullying at school
- The majority of responses highlighted the fact that school was very effective at dealing with bullying and that concerns raised had been dealt with very quickly
- We always tell children to let us know if something is worrying them and we always endeavour to deal with children's concerns very quickly
- Please continue to remind your child to share their concerns with yourselves or an adult at school

Reminders for parents:

- EVERYTHING you need in terms of newsletters / dates / curriculum / homework is available on the school website
- Each class has its own page and newsletters and homework assignments are posted on these pages
- All the dates for the year are on the website and Mrs Statham makes sure you have a year's notice in some cases with the special Fridge Calendar for the Whole Year!
- School regularly posts on school Facebook / school twitter and school Instagram. Please make sure you check social media on a regular basis for news and updates
