Welcome to our St George's family. What are we learning?

Our main focus this half term is ensuring that all children settle happily into school. Our general themes will be my school, ourselves, our family, feelings and our body (healthy eating).

In RE this half term, we will learn about 'Ourselves' and how God loves each of us in our uniqueness.

Literacy – We will be learning to write our name and write the initial sounds in words. We will be doing lots of fine motor activities to help strengthen our hands for writing (lego, colouring, tweezers, jigsaws, playdough). Phonics – We will be practising our oral blending (c-a-t is cat)

and our oral segmenting for spelling. We will be learning to read and write the sounds- s,a,t,p,i,n,m,d,g,o,c,k, e,u,r, h, b, f and we will begin to blend words together (sat, mat). Maths – We will be learning new mathematical vocabulary and applying this to stem sentences. We will also focus on

subitising and solving problems using numbers to 5. Personal, Social and Emotional Development – Children will talk about themselves and their families. Children will learn about classroom routines and talk about what makes them happy.

Physical Development – Move in different ways and develop their gross motor skills.

Understanding the World – Explore their new surroundings inside and outside.
