

Year 2 Autumn 2 Term



Guy Fawkes

This term we will be learning about Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder Plot. Our work in English, art and music will link to this topic. We hope to take a walk into York to look at the house that claims to be the birthplace of Guy Fawkes and the church where he was baptised.

English • We will be developing our descriptive writing this half term. We will be using lots of adjectives to create our own Guy Fawkes 'Wanted' posters! We will also be developing our recount writing skills, as we write an entry of Guy Fawkes' own private diary!

Mathematics • We will be exploring 2d and 3D shapes and their properties. We will be looking at money and number problems involving pence and pounds.

Science • We will be learning all about animals including humans. Finding out about life cycles and what they need to survive.

RE • We will complete our work on Baptism and then move on to learn about Advent. Our Nativity will really help us to understand and to be excited about the Christmas story, we can't wait for you to see it!

History • We will be learning about Guy Fawkes. We will imagine Guy Fawkes living in York as a boy and make comparisons between life now and what it would have been like then. This topic will lend itself to lots of drama and debating!

Art & DT • We will be studying the work of Van Gogh and creating our own versions of his Starry night painting.

R.S.E • The children are continuing the theme created and loved by God. Including sessions on feelings inside and out, anger, keeping healthy, beginnings and endings.

PE: Wednesday and Friday

This term the children need to wear their PE kits to school every Wednesday and Friday. Please ensure they are dressed appropriately for outside sport. They will need jogging tops and bottoms as well as trainers suitable for outside.

<u>Reading</u>
