Reading reminder

English

We will be reading adventure stories linked to the moon and space adventures. We will be writing our exciting space adventure stories. We will also be looking at Newspaper reports and writing a report about the moon landing.

Mathematics

We will focus on understanding money and multiplication and division.

Science

We will be learning about the work of different scientists.

We will find out more about the Local church and we will be learning about the Eucharist.

History

We will be developing our research skills as we find out about the Moon Landing and the life of Neil Armstrong
