Fast from grudges and be reconciled.


Fast from words and be silent so you can listen.


Year 6 led an amazing Ash Wednesday liturgy for us today ~ just before we broke up for half term.

Important Information from City of York
Council and North Yorkshire Police

York City Council have introduced FINES for drivers who leave their car engines ON while their vehicles are stationary.

The "anti-idling" plan approved by the city council, will see drivers asked to switch off their engines. If they refuse they will be issued with a penalty notice.


#### **Photography Competition!**


