This is another note about our upcoming theme this half term 'exploring the past'. We are requesting that you help our learning by uploading a baby picture and a toddler picture of your child. This is so we can teach this topic in a way that specifically relates to your child and can create real-life learning opportunities. You can add them to your child's Tapestry profile, email them to me or send them in an envelope with your child's name.

What are we learning?

In RE this half term we will learn about Gathering and Growing. Literacy – We will use our phonic knowledge to write simple sentences. Phonics – We will be learning to read and write words using the new phase 3 phonic sounds. We will be focusing on the sounds – oa, oo, oo, ar, consolidation, or, ur.

Maths – We will be using numbers upto 10 to explore problem solving, one more, one less, addition, subtraction, doubling and halving. Past and Present - the children will be looking at how they have changed and grown since they were a baby. We are going to use photos to compare St George's school now to in the past.

PE – The children will be developing their throwing and catching skills. Computing – Click and move an object in preparation for coding. Drawing Club – We will be exploring Traditional Tales.
