



Year 2 Spring Term 2

Giants

This term our topic is Giants, we will be looking at Giants in literature in the stories Jack and the Beanstalk and The Selfish Giant by Oscar Wilde. We will also be exploring giants in nature, our Science topic is Plants and we will be finding out about giant trees.

English In English we will be writing a setting description and a newspaper report. In these pieces we will be focusing on our use of ambitious vocabulary and varied sentence structure.

Mathematics

In Maths we will be completing our work on multiplications and division. Then we are going on to look at length, height, mass and capacity.

Science

In Science we are exploring what we need to keep plants healthy and how plants grow. We are also linking into our main topic of giants in nature.

RE

We are finding out about the Eucharist. We will then focus on Lent and Easter.

Geography

In Geography we will be learning about the United Kingdom. We will find out about the giant Finn Mc Cool from Northern Ireland, Benadonner from Scotland, Rhitta Gawr from Wales and Wade from Yorkshire!

We will learn to recognise safe and unsafe situations online and begin to develop an understanding that not everything presented online is true.
