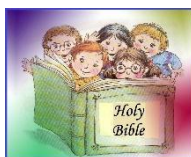
In history we will be learning about the environmentalist Wangari Maathai.

Reading

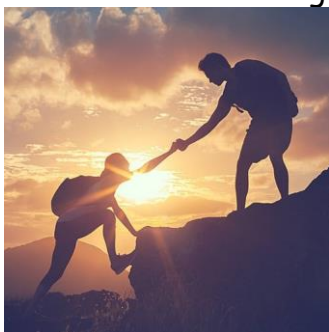


Practise your reading EVERY NIGHT and you will become a super reader.
