Laudato si

This term our topic Laudato si. It focuses on care for the natural environment and all people, as well as broader questions of the relationship between God, humans, and the Earth. We are exploring the impact people have on their communities and will be having lots of circle time discussions about nurturing human wholeness.

English

In English we will be looking at character descriptions and recounts. As a stimulus for some of our writing we will be looking at books linked to our emotions, how these affect our actions and communities.

Mathematics

In Maths we will be learning about Fractions and then time. Alongside this we are reviewing all our learning so far this year and arithmetic methods for addition, subtraction, division and multiplication.

Science

We will be focusing living things and their habitat this half term. We will also look at food chains.

RE

This half term we will learn about Pentecost.

History

We are finding out about Wangari Maathai. Who won a Nobel Peace Prize for her environmental work.

Our lessons centre around a traditional Polish song Tanczymy Labada

To link with our topic we are going to be having circle time discussions about the impact we have on those around us. We will be looking at self- awareness, positive self-esteem, resilience and confidence.
