Year 4 Homework Summer Term 1 2024

TOPIC: Our topic this half term is a Geography topic about the differences between a village, town and city. We will be looking at maps and locating some of the main features of the British Isles.



We would like the children to research a village, town or city of their choice. It could be a place familiar to them, perhaps a holiday destination anywhere in the world. This could be presented in the form of a powerpoint display, a poster or even a 3D model. We would like the children to show where the place is on a map and find out how many people live there (population) and any special features.

READING

Reading is one of the most important things that children learn at school and it is central to most other learning.

Children in year 4, in keeping with our school policy, are asked to read for at least 10-15 minutes every day. This can be on their own, with a sibling or with an adult. Please remember sign and date the reading record and bring it to school each day.

MATHS

This term, we will be working with decimals particularly money. We will be calculating totals and finding change. It's useful to be able to round up to the nearest pound to estimate the cost of items, so please do involve your child in this as you are out shopping so they become familiar with this essential life skill.

We have attached further times table practice sheets with this letter for your child to continue their practice. We will be completing the statutory test in June.









Science

In the first half of this term, we will be finding out about food and digestion. We will also be looking at our teeth and how to keep them healthy. Please design a persuasive leaflet or poster about your teeth and the importance of keeping them healthy.





SPELLING

Please continue to help your child with their spellings. They receive a new list each Monday and have a spelling test on Friday. A list for the term is also attached.
